In the case of joint holders, the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, will be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of the other joint holder(s), and for this purpose seniority will be determined by the order in which the names stand in the register of members.

To be valid, this form of proxy, together with the power of attorney (if any) or other authority (if any) under which it is signed or a notarially certified copy thereof, must be deposited at the Company's branch share registrars in Hong Kong, Tricor Investor Services Limited at Level 54, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Hong Kong not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the meeting (i.e. before 3:00 p.m. on 24 June, 2020) or any adjournment thereof.
- 9. The proxy need not be a member of the Company but must attend the meeting in person to represent you.
- 10. Completion and delivery of the form of proxy will not preclude you from attending and voting at the meeting if you so wish, and in such event, the form of proxy shall be deemed to be revoked.
